Reading the plug:

Look at plug porcelain for colour and condition. Also look at electrode & gap for "rounding" of surface edges.

Porcelain Colour	Sign	
Tan	Normal; mixtures correct; engine fine	
Black dry fluffy	Too rich or excessive idle; check	
Black wet glazed look	Burnt crankcase oil passing piston ring; check Worn piston or ring Worn barrel Crankshaft seals are bad or cases need lapping	
Black wet glazed look	Burnt crankcase oil passing piston ring; check Worn piston or ring Worn barrel Crankshaft seals are bad or cases need lapping	
White coloured	Engine overheating; check Carby mixture too lean Incorrect plug (too hot) Low octane fuel Incorrect timing Cooling problems Leaking crankcase seals, base or head gasket leaks.
